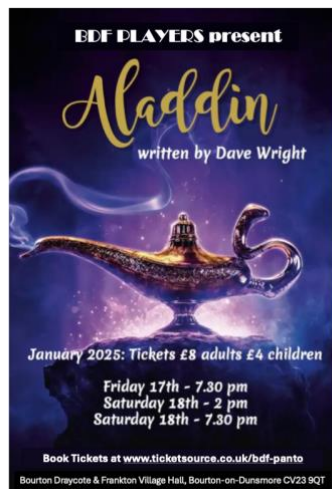
Christmas Market: Sunday 1 December – 10.30am
